

**TOWNSHIP OF SEGUIN
MINUTES OF CEMETERY COMMITTEE MEETING
May 18, 2010**

A regular meeting of the Township of Seguin Cemetery Committee was held on May 18, 2010 at the Township of Seguin Municipal Office. After the meeting was called to order the Chair requested approval of the agenda.

The Chair requested that any disclosures of pecuniary interest be declared. Councillor Jacklin declared a possible indirect conflict of interest with regard to Item number 7 (request to place a marker on lots owned by the Estate of Frank Helmkey).
